## re:act presentations

### 1. **re:act response resource**

target: managers' forums, administration etc.

15 minutes – ½ hour

- overview of the resource, the binder, the materials, website, 1-877# etc.

### 2. **re:act – act on adult abuse and neglect – *it's your duty!***

45 min. – 1 hour

target: any front line staff, physician rounds, acute care, team meetings, managers, etc. that need to know about the duty – can be considered a pre-requisite to the clinical presentation

- brief overview of Adult Guardianship Act, who the law applies to, the VCH role as a designated agency, who the designated responders are and intro. to materials and re:act resource

### 3. **re:act – *recognize* and *report* adult abuse and neglect**

2 – 3 hours

target: designated responders

- clinical assessment, interviewing skills, legislative options, using tools within AGA, ethical decision making

### 4. **re:act – *recognize* and *report* adult abuse and neglect: *act on financial abuse* – a co-presentation with the Public Guardian & Trustee staff**

4 - 6 hours

target: designated responders

- clinical assessment, interviewing skills, legislative options, using tools within AGA, ethical decision making, when and how to involve the Public Guardian and Trustee in situations of financial abuse
